Freelance Guitar Teachers

For 2020, Mary MacKillop College in Leongatha is looking for more music teachers to join the growing music department at the College.

We are currently seeking music teachers who have experience/qualifications in instrumental music teaching on the following instruments:

- Guitar

Mary MacKillop College is a Child Safe School. All applicants must have:

- a current Working with Children's Check and National Criminal History Check or a VIT qualification
- have had experience in teaching instrumental and/or classroom music
- A tertiary qualification in music/music teaching or studying.

The current prices for instrumental music at the College is as per below:

- \$18 for a group of 3 or more (half an hour)
- \$22 for a group of 2 (half an hour)
- \$30 for single student (half an hour)

As a freelance music teacher you are required to invoice the parent/s at an arrangement that suits you (at the beginning of the term, middle or end of the term). This is an arrangement between yourself and the parent/s.

As part of this job you are also required to:

- Participate/be a part of music performances with your students
- Be an active staff member of the College Music Department
- Be engaging, organised and willing to help out within the Music Department
- Be flexible with the timetable and be willing to organise catch up lessons
- Be encouraging and motivating to all students
